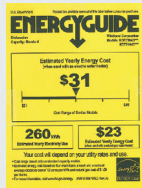


# What did you resolve to do in 2021?

According to EnergyStar.gov, a typical household will spend \$2,000 a year on their energy bills. With ENERGY STAR items—including appliances—you can save 30 percent, or approximately \$575, a year. Older, inefficient appliances waste energy and money. For example, an older refrigerator uses almost twice as much energy as a new ENERGY STAR certified model.

If you are looking to purchase new appliances, remember to look for the ENERGY STAR label. And don't forget to send in a rebate form. Your cooperative offers rebates on ENERGY STAR-rated clothes dryers (\$50), clothes washers (\$50), dishwashers (\$25), freezers (\$25), and refrigerators (\$25).
